Subject:	Discussion with respect to the contents of the official letters received from ECC, Discussion with regard to the decision of ECC based on the deprivation of (6) Wolesi Jirga candidates of their candidacy right, Discussion with reference to giving or not giving the contact numbers of candidates to Mass Media in case of their solicitation, Discussion concerning issuance of accreditations to media and other requesting institutions.

The IEC, based on article (156) of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Afghanistan, decided as follows:

1. As Geezab district is a part of the administrative structure of Daikondi province, the electoral issues of the mentioned district could be related to the province abovementioned too.
2. An official letter is to be sent to ECC about the termination of Vetting Commission working period.
3. The decision of ECC regarding the deprivation of (6) Wolesi Jirga candidates of their candidacy right is confirmed and certified; the candidates deprived of their candidacy right are: Afeefa Shams, Karima Kohistani, Zamin Poya, Parveen Sadat, Fozia Younsi Kakar and Muhammad Hashim Grani.
4. Providing Mass Media with the contact numbers of candidates in case of their solicitation, there is no any legal obstruction and the Commission is allowed to do this.
