- Decision of the ECC regarding disqualifying 4 candidates
- Employing agents for centers and stations which have problems based on assessments of the IEC Secretariat
- Paying two-year membership fee (2008 and 2009) to officials of Asian Election Association
- Providing accreditations to some organizations

Pursuant to article (156) of the Afghan Constitution

The Independent Election Commission, with regard to the above agenda points decided that:

1. Decision of the ECC on disqualifying 4 Wolesi Jirga candidates (Muhammad Afzal, Ms. Shaima Kharotai, Mawlawi Muhammad Asif and Asadullah Hesarshahiwal), is approved and certified.
2. Coming to an understanding with Local Council of Religious Scholars, the secretariat of the Commission must employ 170 special agents to monitor election process in the centers identified to have problems.
3. The Membership fee for years 2008 to 2010 which left unpaid by the IEC, must be paid to the officials of the Asian Election Association
4. The following organizations must be issued with accreditations based on their submitted documents:
 - Danesh, who is foreign journalist

- Muzhda Radio Network
 - Asian TV Network
 - Herat RTA
5. Civilian representatives of NATO who are stationed in Afghanistan and their names are attached to this decision, must be issued with ID cards to attend polling centers and stations as special guests.
