Decision of the Independent Election Commission

Decision Number: 1389 – 112

Subject:

- Polling Station Forms that have not inserted into the system as well as in preliminary list due to lack their arrival to IEC,
- The Re-Counted Votes of Nangarhar Province,
- The Re-Counted Votes of Badakhshan Province

Pursuant to article (156) of the Afghan Constitution

The Independent Election Commission decided that:

1. Those polling stations' forms, whose results have not been received by IEC; accordingly, IEC with understanding ECC, tends to open those ballot boxes containing ballots in presences of electoral monitors, observers, IEC and ECC's representatives so as to take out the copies of the forms from the ballot boxes.

Therefore, IEC ask the relevant PEOs to send the copies of the forms to HQ for further processes. If the ballot boxes contain no copies of the results, the ballots shall be counted and the result to be sent to IEC HQ; hence ECC shall be informed of the issue.

2. Some of Nangarhar polling stations' ballots have been re-counted with reference to IEC's decision and the results have been recently sent to IEC QH. In case of any complaints by ECC in regards with the results inserted into the form of the mentioned polling stations of Nangarhar province, the re-count shall be conducted in presence of electoral monitors, observers, ECC and IEC's representatives and the certified results approved by electoral monitors, observers and representatives of IEC and ECC shall be sent to IEC HQ.

3. The whole result forms of Badakhshan province, whose re-count processes has been took place, shall be consolidated with original forms in presence of electoral monitors, observers, ECC and IEC representatives.
