### Voter Registration Update

IEC is getting ready for the voter list revision and voter registration update which will allow registered voters to check their name on the list and citizens who have not yet registered to be included in the voters list for the upcoming elections.

**Verification & correction:** Voter lists will be published from 1 March 2019 in relevant polling centers where registered voters will be able to check that their name is included and spelled correctly. In case of errors, corrections may be requested while in case of missing name, the person may refer to the provincial offices\*.

**Registration:** All Afghan citizens willing to become a voter and participate in elections who have not yet registered will have such opportunity from 1 March 2019. Can go and register the person who:

- ✓ will turn 18 years old by 20 July 2019;
- ✓ have recently returned to Afghanistan;
- ✓ have the registration sticker on their citizenship Tazkira (national ID) damaged;

**How?** by visiting voter registration centers in person holding citizenship Tazkira.

**When?** voter registration centers will be open every day from 7:00 am to 4:00 pm from 1 to 20 March 2019.

**Where?** at the voter registration centers in the provincial capital, nahias and district centers.

### Candidate Nomination

The candidate nomination process for 2019 Presidential election is taking place from 22 December to 20 January 2019 at IEC HQ in Kabul.

To stand as a candidate, a person must fulfill the candidate eligibility criteria, meet the conditions of candidacy, fulfill the application requirements and appear in person at the IEC Nomination Office in Kabul.

According to article 38 of the electoral law 'a person may nominate himself/herself of the presidency, who meets the following requirements:

- ✓ Shall be an Afghan citizen, a Muslim and born to Afghan parents and shall not have the citizenship of another country;
- ✓ Shall not be less than 40 years of age on the day of candidacy;
- ✓ Shall not have been convicted of crimes against humanity and felony or deprived of civil rights by the court;
- ✓ Shall not have been elected as a president or vice-president for more than two terms.'

Moreover, presidential candidates shall have the support of 100,000 eligible voters, from a minimum of twenty provinces, at least two percent from each province. After the completion of the candidacy period, IEC publishes the preliminary list of candidates. Based on article 44 of the electoral law, ECC will chair a special 'vetting committee' in charge of reviewing candidacies to ensure all applicants do not belong to non-eligible groups (i.e. armed groups). Candidates may address complaints on the preliminary list to ECC within a maximum of two weeks following the publication. After the adjudication of complaints by ECC, IEC publishes the final list of candidates which will also be displayed at PC on election day (article 74 electoral law).



### Stakeholders Engagement

IEC Commissioners have met candidates' delegations from Paktya and Baghlan provinces as well as the Kuchi delegation. Those meetings aimed at hearing complaints of the delegations and take concrete actions to correct issues faced during WJ elections.

IEC and ECC jointly decided to appoint new PEOs and to deploy new teams in both provinces. Concerning Kuchi's main concern, IEC will support them to have their own constituency. Regarding the WJ 2018 results, Kuchi's results will be announced at the end.

### Lessons Learned & Trainings

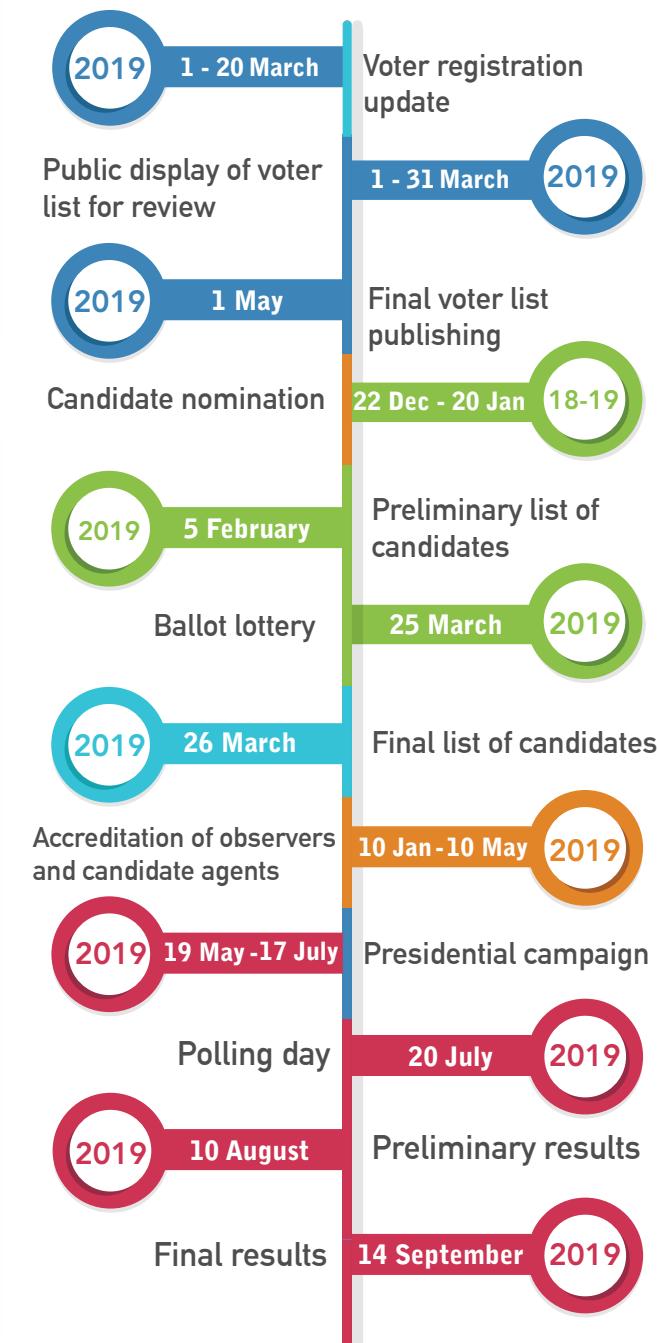


IEC is preparing for the next elections by taking necessary steps that will lead to polling.

With the support of the international community, IEC conducted a three days lessons learned workshop to assess and review WJ elections. The workshop was the occasion for IEC PEO and staff to discuss on challenges, shortcomings and strengths of the process.

A three-days training of trainers was also organized for 68 provincial trainers, two from each province, in view of the upcoming voter registration update and review.

### Tally Process

A total of 4,704 TEB have been intaken at NTC containing 18,446 results forms (RF). So far, 17,723 forms have been registered in the Tally system of which 17,609 RF have completed data entry. Among them, 6,429 recounts forms from 32 provinces.

Kabul province audit and recount process is completed. 2,564 forms have been registered in the Tally system of which 2,479 have been entered in the database.



IEC has announced preliminary results for 32 provinces and Hindu seat. Complaints may be submitted to ECC within 48 hours from publication.
