Decision of the Independent Election Commission

Decision Number: 1389 – 76

Subject:

- ECC's request on inspection and verification of the ballot boxes
- Verification of 11 polling centers of Gero district, situated in Ghanzni province and 4 polling centers of Dahna Ghorī district, situated in Sur-e-Pul province
- Issuance of accreditation cards to Hezb Wadat Islami Afghanistan

Pursuant to article (156) of the Afghan Constitution

The Independent Election Commission decided that:

1. ECC can only verify and ask for re-count process based on the following conditions:
 - If the preliminary results would have announced upon the need of ECC,
 - If the results of above mentioned centers would have not verified by IEC.
2. Eleven polling centers in Ghro district of Ghazni province have been called invalid, since the electoral officials have lost the control of these centers.
3. Due to lack of security, the counting process in three polling centers of Dahan-e-Ghori district had not implemented. Following the retrieval of the ballot boxes to the provincial office, the electoral staffs were unable to conduct counting process due to irregularity made by some of the candidates. These boxes were delivered to the National Tally center

in Kabul after five days. Therefore, ECC has announced these polling centers invalid; thus, IEC approve the decision of ECC and to announce these centers invalid as well.

4. Hezb Wahdat Islami Afghanistan has been provided accreditation cards according to the submitted documents.
