Under Article 13 of the Structural Law of the IEC and IECC and pursuant to the provision of Article 24.3 and Article 55 of the Electoral Law, the Independent Election Commission decided that:

1. The draft protocol of mutual cooperation between the IEC and Central Election Commission of the Russian Federation should be approved and sent to the Embassy of Russian Federation in Kabul.
2. According to the list prepared by the Commission in 2008 Welesi Jirga elections, Engineer Zikria was presented to Wolesi Jirga as a replacement for Mr. Yonus Qanooni.
3. The decisions of the IECC regarding disqualifying provincial council candidates are approved and should be implemented.
4. The following organizations that have submitted necessary documents and signed the relevant code of conduct in accordance with the regulation of the Commission to receive credentials , should be issued with the credentials in the following order:
