Under Articles 13 and 14.1.11 of the Structural Law of the IEC and IECC, the Independent Election Commission decided that:

Polling stations have been determined and certified as follows for the run-off election which was set to be held on June 14, 2014,

1. The polling stations that have been considered for the first round, must remain in their places as before.
2. The polling stations which have been reduced from polling centers in 2010 elections, must be added to their related centers as the mentioned elections.

3. The polling stations that have been considered as contingency stations for specific centers in the first round, must be included in the prime polling stations for the run-off election.
4. As many as 5 % polling stations must be added to each province and also 5% contingency polling stations must be considered in each province for the run-off election
5. Increase in polling stations for the run-off election must be made more in the polling centers in which complaints about shortfalls of ballots made in the first round election.
