



INDEPENDENT ELECTION COMMISSION (IEC): PROCEDURES AND GUIDELINES FOR ENTRY TO THE IEC COMPOUND AND OBSERVATION OF THE NATIONAL TALLY CENTER

ENTRY TO THE COMPOUND

All persons or parties wishing to enter the Independent Election Commission (IEC) compound should provide the following information to the IEC:

- Time of proposed visit;
- Purpose of visit, including buildings and individuals they wish to visit (except for accredited observers);
- Full names of all visitors, including identification number and type; and
- Make, model, color and plate number of each vehicle to enter the compound.
- Visitors should also indicate whether they will be accompanied by close protection.

ENTRY TO THE NATIONAL TALLY CENTER

All persons or parties wishing to visit the National Tally Center (NTC), even if they are already accredited, will require a badge before they may enter the NTC premises. To obtain this badge, they will be required to report to the External Relations/Accreditation Office, and should produce two passport-sized photographs.

The tally center badge will enable its holder to enter the NTC, observe the intake process and to observe data entry from a demarcated area. Once every hour, there will be a guided tour of the correction area.

In order to avoid interference and to protect the integrity of the process, visitors are requested to kindly keep noise to a minimum, avoid lingering, and refrain from using their mobile phones.
